FRATELLI GROSJEAN WINERY

A breathtaking landscape welcomes visitors of this winery, located among the borders of two towns -Quart and Saint Christophe- in Valle d'Aosta.

Here are cultivated vineyards of Tzeriat, Rovettaz, Creton, Touren a Quart, Merletta, Castello Passerin d'Entreves e Senin a Saint Christophe. All of these plantations are 100% biologic: this winery does not use any chemicals or insecticides on their grapes.

Visiting this winery can be described as a sensorial experience, that culminates with the wine tasting.

FERRARI WINERY

The visit of the Ferrari Winery has always been described as a unique and evocative experience. It's possible to take part in a guided tour all year long. The tour begins with a short video that explains the birth of the winery and the origins of the Ferrari family, that have been owning the company for three generations.

During the tour you will be taken right in the depths of the cellar, where you will be able to admire a copious amount of wine and prosecco bottles.

The tour ends with a toast in the Ferrari Incontri Building which was created for the purpose of welcoming guests in the winery.

MARCHESI BAROLO

The Marchesi Barolo Winery is located in the historical winery of their castle.

Up to this day it is a family owned business, consisting in 130 hectares of vineyards which produce Barolo, Barbaresco, Nebbiolo d'Alba, Barbera d'Alba, Dolcetto d'Alba, Roero Arneis, Gavi, Moscato d'Asti and Brachetto d'Acqui

Marchesi Barolo Winery received numerous awards for its wines and it's not uncommon to find articles about it on both local and international press. The winery exports its product in over 45 different Countries, including south east Asia.

On top of the historical winery, a series of buildings have been built for the purpose of welcoming guests in their tasting room and a wine shop.

CENTRO AZIENDE VITIVINICOLE

Cerreto family has been producing wine for 3 generations now. The Cerretos founded this cubic building as an homage to Barolo. Visitors can partake in two different guided tours. The first one is called Wine and Art and along with the visit to the winery and the wine tasting, it's also included a tour of Cappella della Brunate. The second tour is called Barolo and Architecture and it takes visitors inside the cubic building -Bricco Rocche- and then to Monsordo winery for wine tasting.

CA' MAIOL

Ca' Maiol winery is in Desenzano sul Garda and is a family-run business with state of the art technology, surrounded by a charming view of the Lugana region. It's wine is getting a lot of recognition both on local and foreign markets.

The winery was founded but Walter Contado after a trip to Sirmione where he was inspired in creating his own wine business with this 110hectars of property. The production grows day by day, gifting us a wine of great potential that is slowly getting recognition among the great italian whines.

PICCHI VINI

The Picchi bussiness was built 50 years ago on the hills that adjoin the town of Casteggio. The Picchi family has been in the business fo over 50 years. Producing wines with the exquisite grapes of Oltrepo' Pavese-. Recently the owners have decided to use their grapes also for producing for top quality wines, a good way of expressing the potentiality of this land.



BARONE PIZZINI WINERY

It was 1971 when Barone Pizzini produced his first bottle of franciacorta. 50 years later a tour will guide you through the secrets that led to the winet fame and success. The winery - located close to Bresci. - was the first one ever to produce an organic Franciacorta wine. During the tour you will be able to taste Franciacorta Animante, Barone Pizzini or the Editions. At the end you will be served Franciacorta Golf 1927, Naturae 2013 and Rosè 2013.

BANFI CASTLE

Banfi winehouse is located inside some ancient buildings belonging to the castle and offers to the visitor the chance to taste wines, grappa, extra virgin olive oil, honey pasta and cakes. It is also possible to buy books regarding wine, tuscan gastronomy, history and architecture. Besides the winehouse, in Banfi Castle is possible to visit the Balsameria, where the Salsa Etrusca is made. This condiment is a more refined version of balsamic vinegar, left to age in small barrels made of selected woods and it's made with grapes that are harvested later during the year.

CIACCI PICCOLOMINI D'ARAGONA

This winery is located on the east side of Montalcino, in close proximity of the medieval hamlet of Castelnuovo dell'Abate and the famous abbey of Sant'Antimo. The property consist of 225 hectares of land dedicated for the most part to vineyards and a smaller portion to olive groves. The vineyards are in the heart of Val d'Orcia -which is UNESCO world's heritage- with his unique landscape circumscribed by Mount Amiata.



VILLA VIGNAMAGGIO

This winery is located in a XIV century villa in Greve in Chianti. Today 62 hectares of the villa's lands are occupied by vineyards. Most of them are of Sangiovese quality -the typical vine used for Chianti- and part of it of Cabernet Franc.

Visitors can have a guided tour of the winery and enjoy the beautiful park of Villa Vignamaggio, after having a wine tasting with some wines produced there.



PETRA WINERY

The winery is located in Piombino and its buildings is shaped like a big cylinder covered with Prun stone. The construction of the building allows natural light to enter all of its areas. There is a spacious staircase leading the visitor to a small hill where it is possible to admire the sea. Through a long gallery that cuts through the hill, visitors can admire all the different phases of wine production.

CASALE DEL GIGLIO

This winery is located in Alprilia, in the province of Latina, almost 50km south of Rome. This winery took inspiration from the way that vineyards were cultivated in places surrounded by the sea, like Bordeaux, Australia or California, since it faces the coast of Tyrrhenian Sea. Through researches approved by the European Community this winery planted in the area of Latina new kinds of vineyards, such as Chardonnay, Sauvignon and Syrah. The main production of the winery consists of red Syrah grapes, white Sauvignon, Viognier and Petit Maseng grapes.

SANT'ANDREA WINERY

The winery has different vineyards, but the most notable is the one of Terracina. This vineyard consists in 15 hectares of land, surrounded by the countryside in the uncontaminated nature of a hill 400m above the sea level. The vines cultivated are the most ancient of the area and they are used to make the Moscato di Terracina, Cesanese di Terracina, Aleatico and Cecubo - a wine that has been produced since the roman empire.

FEUDI DI SAN GREGORIO

This winery is located in the region of Irpinia, in the town of Sorbo Sepico in the Avellino province. This is a mountain area with a cool climate. The main building of the area was restructured in 2001 by the Sapporo based architect Hikaru Mori, this making the winery an important architectonic landscape of the nation, that was featured twice in the Architecture Biennale of Venice. Among the wines produces here, the most noticeable are the whites Fiano d'Avellino, Greco di Tufo and Falanghina and the reds Tauris and Aglianico. The bottles' labels were created by an italian designer whose work has been exposed also in New York's MOMA.




CANTINA VARVAGLIONE 1921

The winery is located in Leporano, in the province of Taranto, and it's famous for the vast variety of wines produced here with a technique that blends tradition and innovation with particular regard for local vines. The winery was founded in 1921 and it includes more than 1500 hectares of vineyards systematically controlled by the Universities of Udine and Bologna.

The local vines are among the favourites in the production of the winery, consisting in Primitivo di Manduria, Malvasia Nera and Negroamaro.

Some of these wines have received numerous awards both nationally and internationally, reflecting the quality of the products coming from Puglia.
